Written Misconduct reports must be filled out and emailed to [assign@swisra.org](mailto:assign@swisra.org) within 24 hours. Referees who do not file their misconduct paperwork will no longer be assigned. If you have questions, ask.
4. Where guest players are allowed by the Rules of Competition, you are required to list them in the Comments section of the game report.
5. If you issue a yellow and/or red card, in addition to filing the written paperwork, you are required to state the details for each card in the Comments section of the game report. Refer to the LOTG for proper terminology. Sloppy writing is not professional.
6. If there is anything you want the league or assignor to know or you just need to vent, put it in the Comments. League representatives read all the Comments.
7. Click "Save".

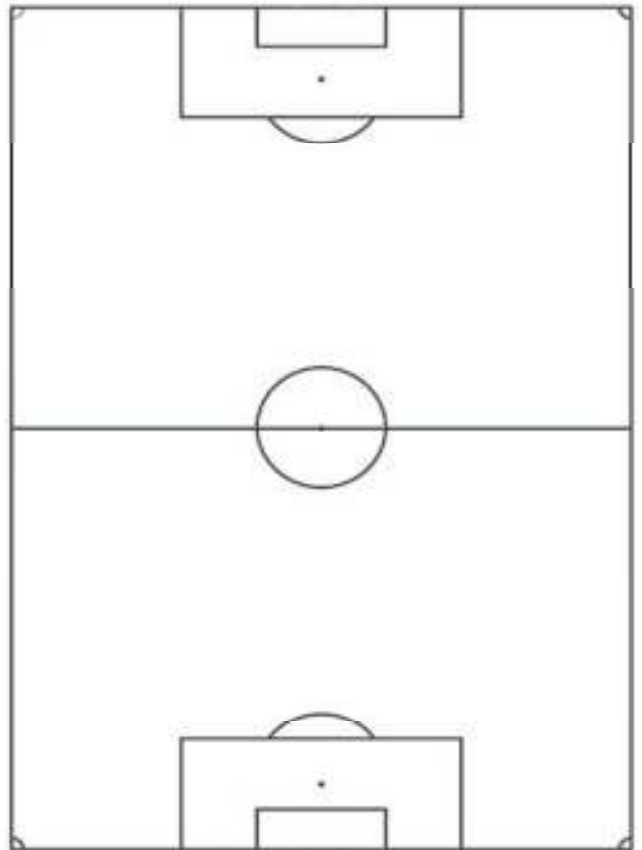
